



Busy Bees High-5 Charts support setting up a classroom with a Busy Bee theme but can be used in any early childhood classroom.

The resource is comprised of **3 posters**:

- Bee friendly
- Bee resilient
- Blank (for your own)

The High-5

The high-5 is often used to recognise an achievement.

It is also used by many as a strategy for remembering how to act in certain situations e.g. how to be a good friend in the playground (**Bee friendly**) or what to do if you have a problem in the playground for example, being teased, someone won't play (**Bee resilient**).

These two posters can be used to teach children appropriate strategies.

A blank poster is also included. This can be used to create your own poster using words and suggestions particular to your situation.
