



9 square Christmas puzzle

These puzzles make a lovely gift for Christmas or to finish the school year.

They provide a challenging activity for fast finishers or waiting times, or can be given to students as part of a Christmas gift to use at home.

Instructions:

Print out one puzzle for each child.

Cut along the lines to separate the 9 puzzle pieces. (The parts extending outside the large square will be discarded.)

Store each child's puzzle pieces in a snap lock bag or envelope (labelled with name).

Note: To ensure lost pieces are returned to correct child/puzzle, paper of different colours can be used, and children's names can be printed on the reverse of each piece. An editable Word document is available for this purpose. (See [9 square insect puzzle — names for back](#))

If the puzzles are being given as a gift to take home, it is unnecessary to add names.
