



About me booklet – How to use

The *About me booklet* supports the establishment of a supportive classroom environment in which each child feels valued and respected.

Children complete their own booklets which can be read to each other, displayed in the reading corner, or taken home and read to family and friends.

Display the interactive resource *About me – Modelled writing* on the interactive whiteboard to demonstrate how to complete the booklets.

Printing the booklet

The booklet is designed for double sided printing.

If you have a printer that prints double sided, choose the options below.



Note: Print one test booklet before doing a full run to ensure correct setting.

If you need to manually print double-sided, print sheets one and two back-to-back, and sheets three and four back-to-back.

Fold the booklet to A5 size and staple in the centre.

Suggestions for completing the booklet

Cover – Write full name and date. If desired, decorate with favourite things.

Hello page – Draw a full-body picture of self, or add a photograph. (Circle "boy" or "girl".)

Age page – Draw a birthday cake and candles to indicate age.

Family page (double page spread) – Draw and label family members.

Toy – Draw a picture of self with favourite toy.

Friend – Draw a picture of self and friend engaged in activity together.
