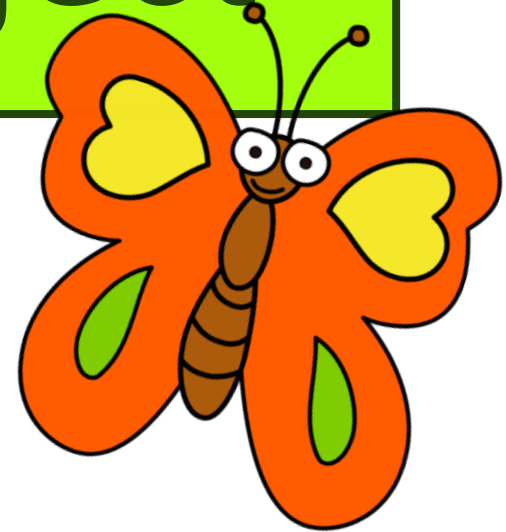
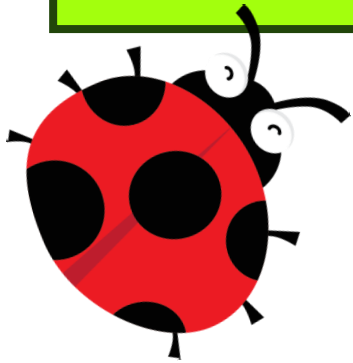


Ideas for presenting your  
minibeast project



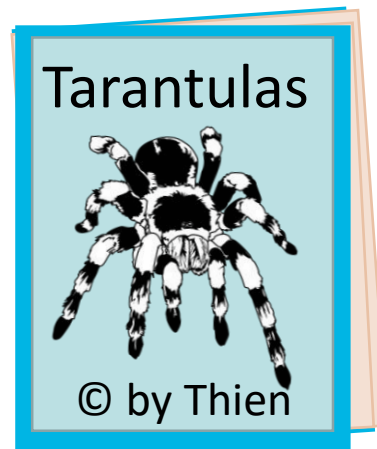
## Information to include in your minibeast project:

(✓ the box when you have found and recorded the information)

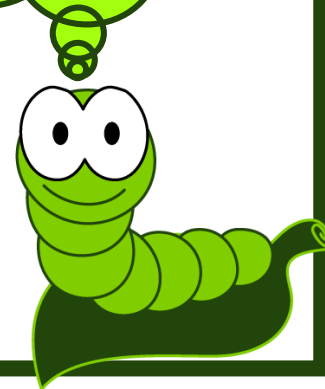
- The type of minibeast e.g. butterfly, bee, snail, tarantula
- A description, for example:
  - legs
  - wings
  - antennae
  - body parts
  - fangs
  - eyes
  - tail
  - colour
  - pattern
  - other interesting or distinguishing features
- What food it eats
- How it eats
- How it moves
- Its home
- Where it lives
- Who it lives with
- How its babies are born
- Its life stages
- Other interesting facts

# Make a book

- Write your information on different pages.
- Illustrate it.
- Staple it together.
- Remember to give your book an interesting cover!

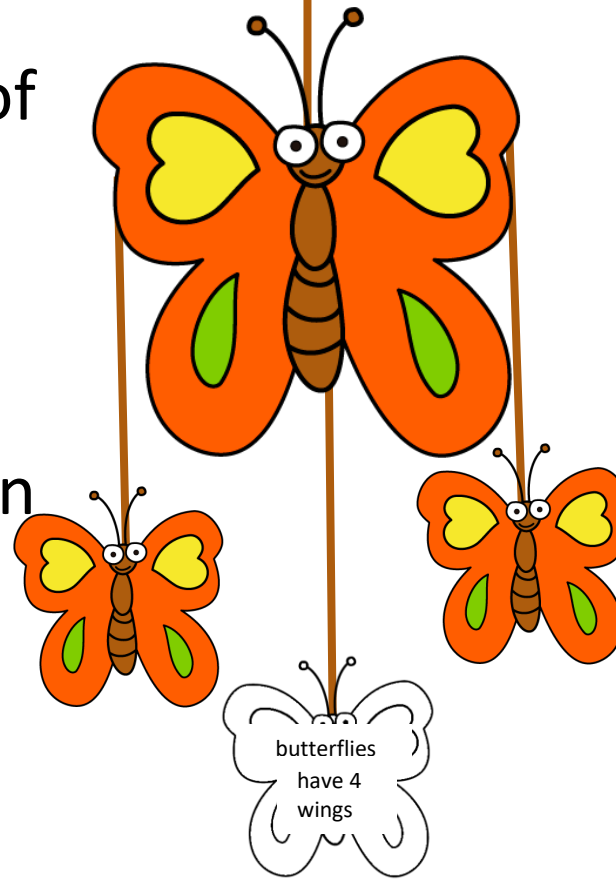


What about a shape book?

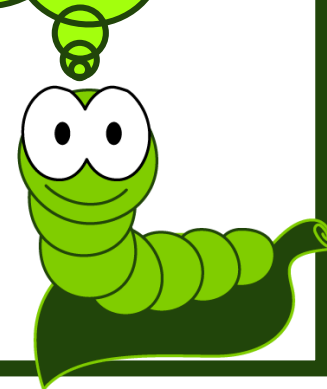


# Make a mobile

- Make a large picture of your minibeast.
- Make smaller cut-out shapes of your minibeast.
- Write your information on the shapes.
- Hang them from the larger picture.



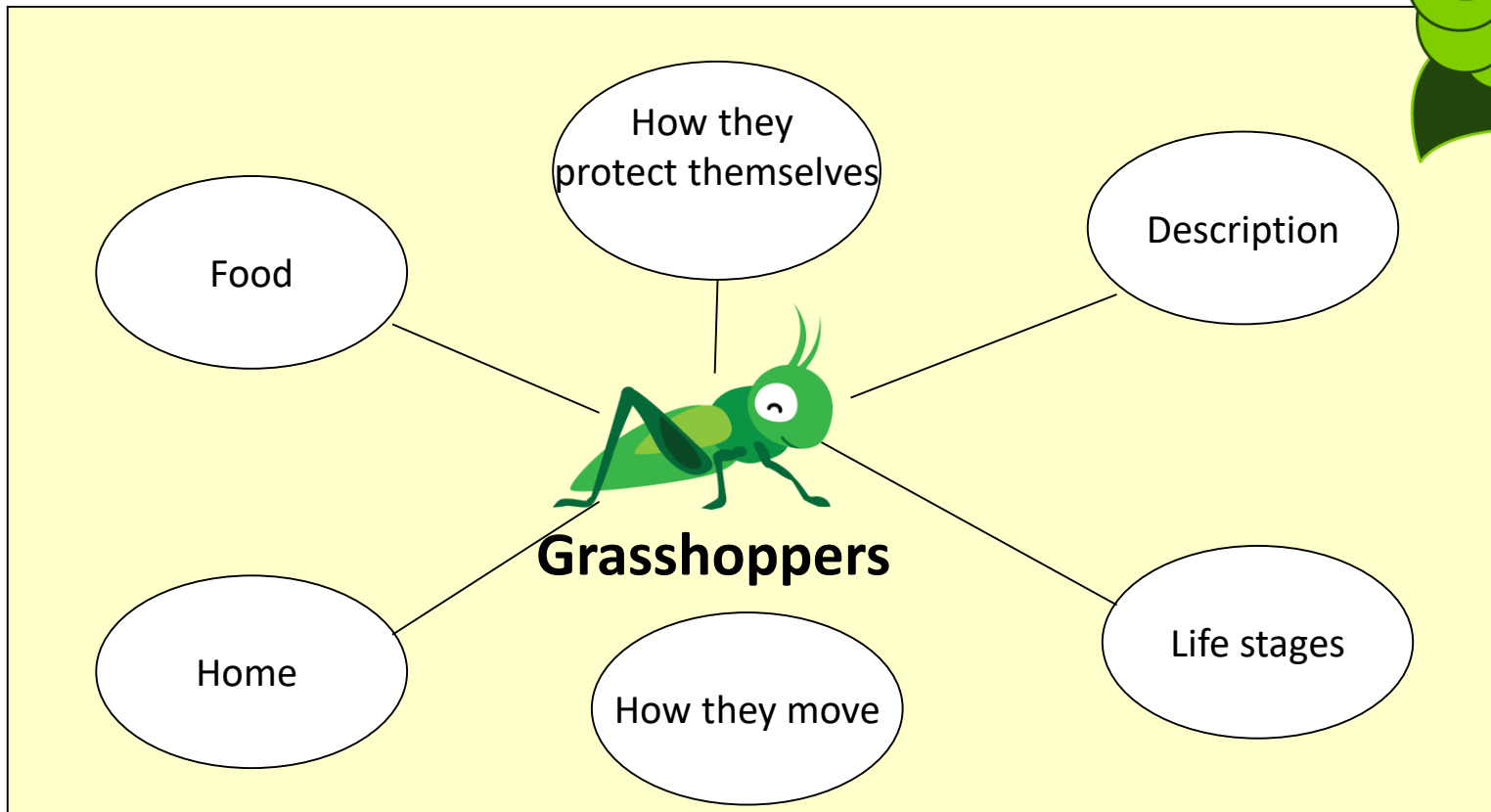
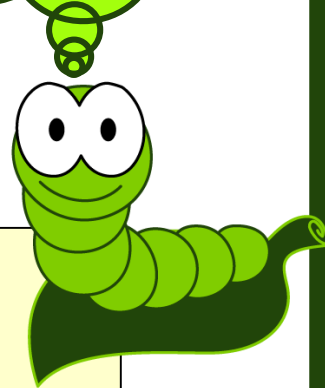
Use cut-outs of the life stages for the life stages information!



# Make a poster

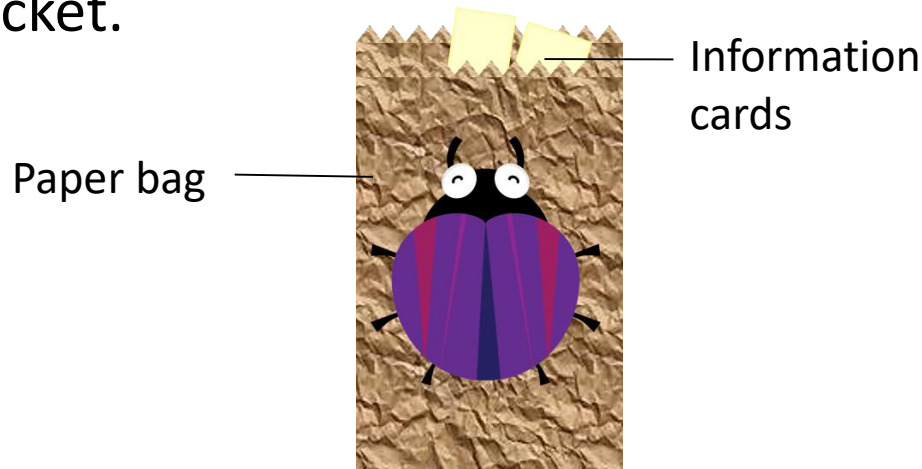
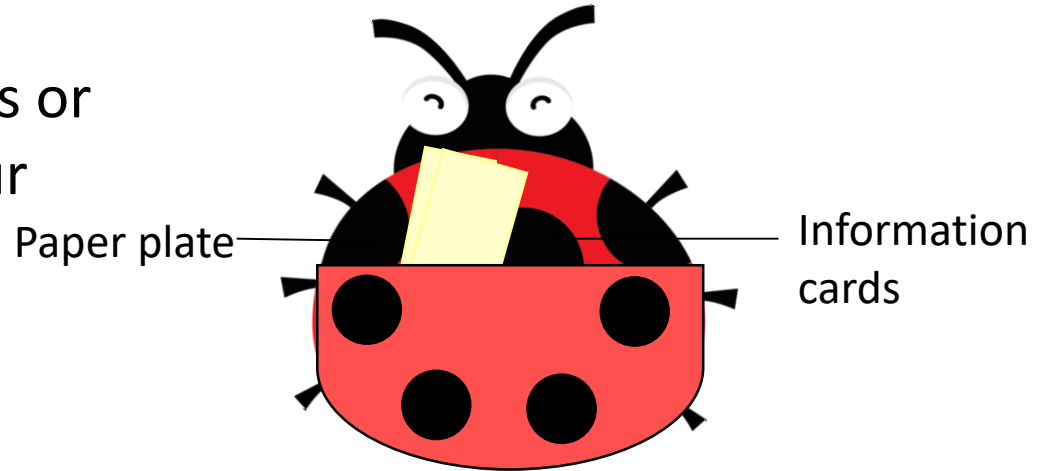
Add some fun facts to your chart!

- Start with a large piece of paper.
- Draw a picture and write the name of your minibeast.
- Add your information and pictures to the chart.



# Make a pocket project

- Decorate some paper plates or a paper bag to look like your minibeast.
- Write your information on cards.
- Put the cards inside the pocket.



# Make a diorama

- Use an empty box to create your minibeast's habitat.
- Decorate it with objects that are found in the habitat. Label them.
- Make a model of your minibeast to go in the habitat.
- Write your information on cards to go in a pocket or stand in front of your diorama.



If your minibeast lives in trees, you could make a model of a tree, then write the information on the leaves!



# Make a slide show

- Make a slide show about your minibeast.
- Make a title page with the name and a picture of your minibeast. Be sure to add your name too!
- Create different slides for different parts of your information.
- Draw pictures or add clip art to illustrate each slide.
