A group of horses is a **herd**.



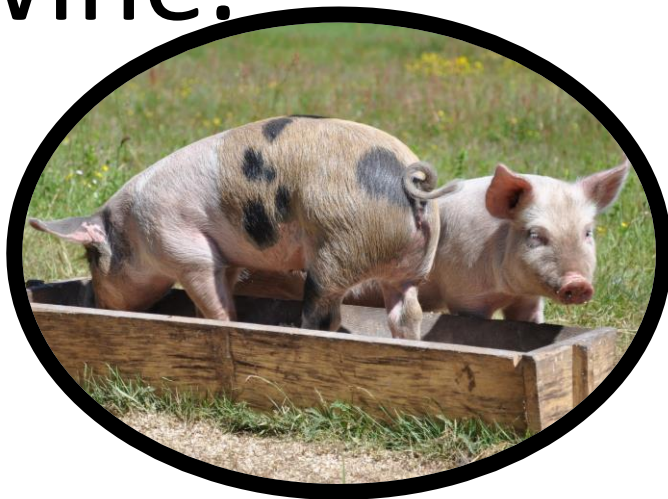
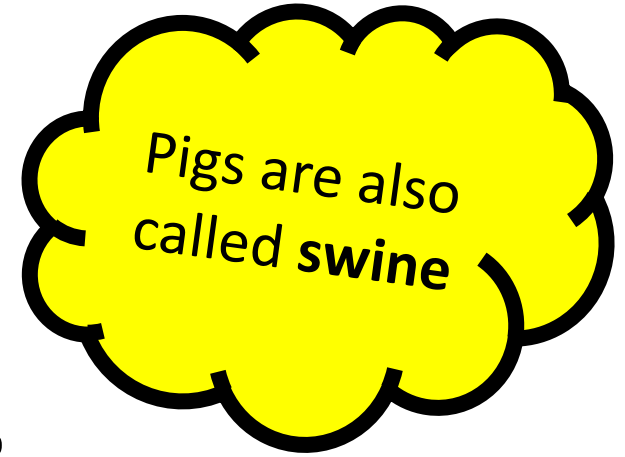
Pigs

A group of pigs is a **sounder** of swine.



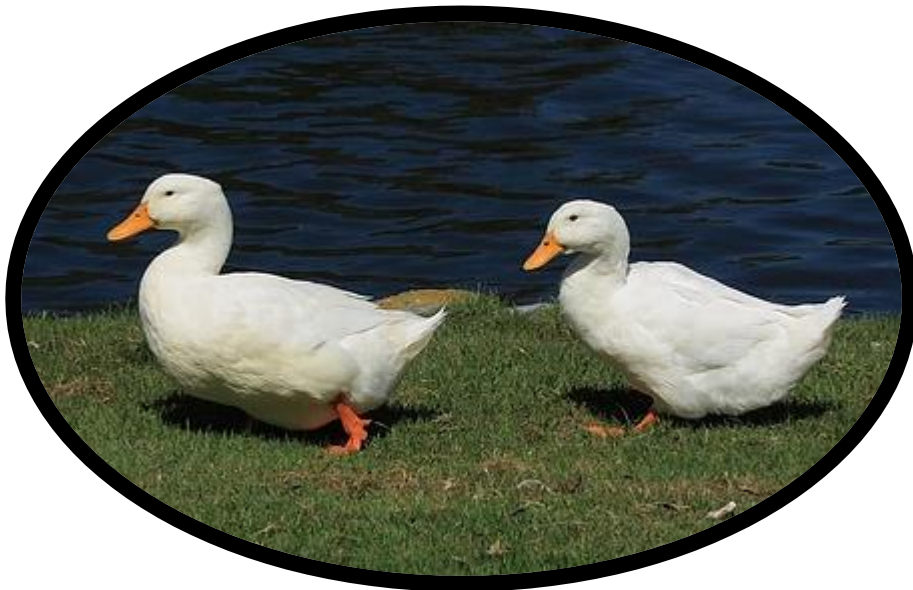
Ducks
